#### 4 Areas of Dialogue for Effective Communication

- <u>Dialogue of Purpose</u> Teams must understand why they exist and how they serve the greater organization
- <u>Dialogue of Personality</u> The better that teams get to know each individual's disposition, the better they'll be able to work through conflict
- <u>Dialogue of Function</u> When teams know their general skillset(s), they can better operate in their strength zone and identify opportunities for improvement
- <u>Dialogue of Vocabulary</u> Teams must norm on the use of terminology to maintain clarity and avoid confusion
